



ALL ABOUT PARKING - SEPTEMBER 2019

Day Parking is provided and facilitated by the Solano County Fair Association. Lake-Drake Cluster has no authority over issues regarding day parking. Handicapped parking is available and typically provides an appropriate surface to the facilities; it is not necessarily closer to the buildings or rings.

PLEASE NOTE: Main gate to grounds closes promptly at 10 p.m. with absolutely no admittance after that time.

OVERNIGHT VEHICLES, those with passes and exhibitors, enter the Expo Gate.

- 1. Advance fee, \$45.00 per night. Overnight begins at 4 p.m. Please check below which night(s) you are staying. There will be a \$20.00 charge for all returned checks.
- 2. Tag-along/tow vehicles \$30.00 flat fee (must fit in your space).
- 3. Any payment at gate must be in CASH at a fee of \$65.00 per night and must be for the balance of the weekend. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 4. All RVs using a generator must have a proper exhaust pipe venting away from the dogs and people. Quiet Time: 10 p.m. - 6 a.m. No generators.
- 5. 20 AMP ELECTRICAL HOOKUPS FOR \$10 PER DAY IF AVAILABLE (including Concourse). Include payment below and indicate how many nights.
- 6. Wednesday parking hours: 12 p.m. to 10 p.m.
- 7. ALL overnight parking must be inside the gate by 7:30 a.m. on show days or else wait until after Best in Show judging (will have to go in Main Lot and pay parking fee).
- 8. Gates open at 6 a.m. Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday and close at 10 p.m. Thursday-Saturday. No overnight parking on Sunday. Grounds must be vacated one hour after Best in Show on Sunday.
- 9. Reservations close August 28, 2019, after which time there will be no cancellations or refunds.
- 10. Make check payable to Lake-Drake Cluster and mail with form below to: Wayne Hayes, 6224 Burns Way, Sacramento, CA 95824: 916/997-2559
- 11. Note: Some areas are only for overnight vehicles.
- 12. No vehicle traffic within show limits during judging hours. No exceptions.

Notice to Exhibitors

- Conditional, telegraph, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries without fees are not acceptable. Fees must accompany entries. Highest price class is considered first entry.
- Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- PLEASE TYPEWRITE or NEATLY PRINT all entries. Use black or blue ink. DO NOT use pencil or colored ink to write entries. Generic entry forms are available on-line at www.going-2-dogs.com.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries.
 Changes are not acceptable by telephone. Email or faxed changes are allowed.
- 5. ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS Owners alone are responsible for the correctness of entries, or for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
- As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.
- 7. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If, because of riots, wars, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellation, call AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229.
- 3. CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, please notify the Show Secretary.
- DECLINATION OF ENTRIES: The Club may decline any entry for cause, and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
- 10. PLEASE NOTE: Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Sec 6)
- DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- 12. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and/or its Show Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
- 13. There are no provisions for unentered dogs at this show. All dogs shall be kept on leash or confined, except when being judged or in the exercising ring.
- 14. ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the owner or the agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, and the Show Secretary should be advised at once of any discrepancy. The showgiving club and its officials disclaim any liability for any awards not claimed on the day of the show.
- 15. The welfare of the exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor and they will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times at the show.
- 16. The Club will take every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the Redwood Empire Mastiff Club will not be responsible for loss. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.
- Matting is required in all exercise pens.

- Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered and shown in Veteran classes at Independent and Concurrent Specialty Shows.
- Winners of the Veterans classes may also compete in the Best of Breed Competition, provided that they
 are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed or Variety competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, or Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records.

OWNER-HANDLED BEST OF BREED

This event qualifies for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series. Exhibitor MUST check the Owner-Handled checkbox on the AKC Entry Form to be eligible. See information on Page 8.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class:

Open to stud dogs and at least two and no more than three of their get. Stud Dog and get do not necessarily need to be owned by the same person(s). Get must be entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class at this show. Award will be based on the merits of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require a Disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed, other than Stud Dog need not be intact.

Brood Bitch Class:

Substitute "Brood Bitch" for Stud Dog, "Produce" for Get.

SPECIAL AWARDS

- Award of Merit At the conclusion of Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best of Winners, the judge may award at his/her discretion Awards of Merit to up to 10% of the entry in Best of Breed. The judge is not obligated to award any Awards of Merit if he/she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. All dogs competing in the Best of Breed competition are eligible for this award, with the exception of the BOB and BOS winners.
- Best Puppy in Regular Classes Chosen from the winners of Puppy Dogs 6-9, Puppy Dogs 9-12, Puppy Bitches 6-9, and Puppy Bitches 9-12.
- Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Chosen from winners of BBE Dogs and BBE Bitches.
- Best Veteran Chosen from the winners of the six (6) Veteran classes.

Puppy Sweepstakes Rules

- The REMC Puppy Sweepstakes is open to Mastiffs who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Champions of Record and dogs with Championship Points are allowed.
- Each dog entered must be handled by the owner, by a member of owner's immediate family, or by a
 breeder or co-breeder, with the exception that professional handlers may handle only dogs that they
 own/co-own or are the breeder/co-breeder of record and handle without recompense, and all prize money
 is to be the property of the owner.
- All dogs shown in Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular classes. Use the same entry
 form, indicating "Sweepstakes" and the age division in the box labelled "Additional Classes." Entry fee is
 \$16.50 in addition to the appropriate entry fee for the regular class.
- All AKC rules applying to the regular classes also apply to the Sweepstakes classes.
- The first place winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. There is no Junior/Senior division.
- Cash prizes will be awarded to the person in the ring showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be
 made in the ring before judging is over. The Show Secretary and REMC will disclaim any liability for cash
 prizes after the judging of Sweepstakes is completed.

Veteran Sweepstakes Rules

- The same above rules apply to the Veteran Sweepstakes with the following exceptions:
- The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Mastiffs who, on the date of the show, are 6 years and older. The same ownership and professional handler rules apply.
- Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes do <u>not</u> need to be entered in a regular or non-regular class and may be spayed or neutered.
- To enter, write "Veteran Sweepstakes" and with the age division in the space provided for in "Additional Classes". Entry fee is \$16.50.
- All first place winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION

Junior Showmanship Competition

AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBERS are required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club at phone (919) 233-9767, or online at juniors@akc.org. For additional information contact the American Kennel Club at 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Ste 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390. When entering this show, be sure to include all information required on both the front and back of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Junior Showmanship classes to be offered are:

- <u>NOVICE CLASS</u> For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.
- OPEN CLASS For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the
 day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards with
 competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.
- MASTER CLASS For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won ten (10) First Places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member show. The calendar for this class will be November 1 October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry without charge, the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

<u>BEST JUNIOR HANDLER</u> will be selected from the winners of each Junior Showmanship class. Competition is not required for award.

ELIGIBILITY - For Mastiffs only. Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a breed judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused under the Dog Show Rules for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

<u>SUBSTITUTIONS</u> - A dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an Official AKC Entry Form along with an additional fee if required. All such substitutions must be made ½ hour prior to the judging of the Junior Showmanship classes at the show. All eligibility criteria must be met. A Junior Handler is limited to one substitution per show.

Conformation Awards

National Owner-Handler Series

Determining Eligibility:

- * Exhibitors must declare their dog AKC National Owner-Handled Series eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.
- * The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the steward's book and in the show catalog.

- * The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

Determining Owner-Handled Best of Breed

* Breed judging for OH Best of Breed is conducted following Best of Breed judging in the ring. All dogs in BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members, and current assistants to a professional handler, and any exhibitor that did not indicate on their entry that they were eligible for NOHS to leave the ring. The judge will then select the Owner-Handled Best of Breed. A dog being "cut" or otherwise "defeated" in the BOB ring remains eligible to compete for Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
